The DeLand Sculpture Walk is a collaborative effort between The City of DeLand, Florida and the Museum of Art - DeLand, offering established and emerging artists the opportunity to display their sculptures throughout the heart of beautiful downtown DeLand.

The artwork changes annually, revealing a variety of artistic styles through the use of concrete, aluminum, stainless steel, PVC, bronze, copper and other materials.
